Residents of the City of Milton affected by the Flooding Events of April 29-30, 2014

Any city resident who has suffered a loss due to the flooding event mentioned above, should go to Santa Rosa County's website <http://www.santarosa.fl.gov/> and click on the large box titled "Apply for Disaster Assistance-FEMA / Click to Report Property Damage" where you can submit your claim for the Individual Assistance Program (IAP) under the Presidents Declaration #4177-DR, issued May 2, 2014. **All damage claims for IAP must be routed through Santa Rosa County.**

For those who do not have access to the internet, individuals and businesses who need assistance should call the toll-free tele-registration hotline, available through the Federal Emergency Management Agency at 1-800-621-FEMA (3362) (TTY: 1-800-462-7585).

Additionally, Santa Rosa County has requested FEMA open disaster recovery centers as soon as possible. A disaster recovery center offers residents the opportunity to meet with representatives of federal, state, local, and volunteer organizations who are offering assistance to disaster survivors in one location.
