In accordance with City of Milton Ordinances, City of Milton, Florida:

City Ordinance 565 states, in part: “Written application shall be made to the Chief of Police of Milton, Florida at least two (2) weeks prior to the time set for said activity.” If permissible, the Chief of Police shall grant a written permit for such function, prescribing the times, streets or other public ways which may be used. If not permissible, the application may be denied or possibly an alternative may be suggested if time allows. The Chief of Police shall not issue any permit for a parade, procession or other public demonstration during the period of time from 9:00 P.M. to 8:00 A.M.
